THE CREATION OF ANGELS

- They were celebrating at the beginning of creation – Job 38:4-7; Psalms 104:4-5
- Unlike humans, all the angels were created at one point in time. Matthew 22:30
- Angels cannot be counted – Hebrew 12:22
- They can be invisible but also visible – Numbers 22:31; II Kings 6;16-17; Hebrews 13:2
- It is always alarming when an angel appears; always associated with “*Fear Not*” – the announcement of His birth; the announcement of His resurrection.
- Angels are immortal. Luke 20:36; Daniel 9 Gabriel appears to Daniel and 500 years later he appears to Zacharias.
Luke 1:11-12, 19
- Angels are incredibly strong – Psalms 103:20; Daniel credits them for caring for him in the Lions den; II Kings 19:35
