DO ANGELS WATCH OVER US?

- Old Testament promises. Psalms 91:1-2, 11-13.
- New Testament teachings. I Corinthians 4:9
- Angels intervene in our lives. Daniel 6:22; Acts 5:19; 12:7-10; 27:23-25

DO WE HAVE A GUARDIAN ANGEL?

- There are only two verses that indicate there might be guardian angels in the world today> Matthew 18:10; Acts 12:14-15 where Peter was released from jail.
- Incidence where angels come to help us. Luke 16:22 escorted to heaven. Matthew 26:53 @ His arrest in the Garden of Gethsemane. Luke 22:43 when Jesus was praying in Gethsemane. Genesis 16:10-11 encourages Hagar
